PROJECT EXPERIENCE

Under contract with Murphy Oil Company, Fisher Arnold completed an emergency response to a carrier gasoline spill incident in Rockwood, TN. Fisher Arnold worked with emergency response contractors in order to implement site specific health & safety plans, document response activity, ensure proper regulatory notifications, and conduct vapor monitoring as needed in the immediate area of the incident. When necessary, representative soil samples or basin water samples are collected in order to develop release incident reports and appropriateness of clean-up.

Although it was confirmed that only approximately 50 gallons was released, care was taken to document all response activity and ensure workers that safe conditions were maintained during and after the spill incident.
