PROJECT EXPERIENCE

Fisher Arnold, along with Burns & McDonnell, Inc. provided planning/programming for an area of approximately 70 acres of an Air Cargo facility just north of the Tennessee National Guard site. The project included the fast track design and construction documents for the extension of Taxiway Papa and Phase I of the Air Cargo Ramp. Our services included the design of over 22 acres of concrete pavement, grading, drainage, utilities, striping, erosion control, electrical and lighting and was completed in approximately 60 days. We assisted the Memphis-Shelby County Airport Authority (MSCAA) with Construction Administration services including weekly construction meetings, shop drawings and submittal review, and periodic site visits.

In another phase of the project, Fisher Arnold and Burns & McDonnell also completed the Phase I Air Cargo Building and associated civil design. This project included the building, airport concrete pavement, landside concrete pavement, grading, and drainage for this \$7 million project. The project included design and preparation of all contract documents, and setting a preliminary profile for the future Hurricane Crossing connecting Taxiway Papa and Taxiway Yankee.
