PROJECT EXPERIENCE

Fisher Arnold provided services to the City of Germantown for the \$1.3m reconstruction and paving for portions of Wolf River Boulevard from Farmington Boulevard to the eastern City Limits with STP funding. Fisher Arnold completed the NEPA document for this project as well as design and construction plans. The project consisted of partial reconstruction of existing pavement, milling, overlaying, sidewalk and handicap ramp construction. Fisher Arnold prepared traffic control plans for this busy roadway and monitored the traffic control during construction. Fisher Arnold also provided the CEI Services for this project which included inspection of asphalt milling, asphalt paving, concrete curb & gutter, sidewalk, and handicap ramps.
