Water Treatment and Distribution System Improvements Rossville, Tennessee



PROJECT EXPERIENCE

Fisher Arnold was contracted to design multiple improvements to the Town of Rossville's water treatment and distribution system. The work at the water plant, at a cost of \$900,000, included new high service pumps which double the plant's output, a new aerator, a new well, piping, complete electrical rehabilitation, a new natural gas-powered emergency generator, and complete controls rehabilitation. Other system improvements include piping upgrades and an emergency generator for a water booster pump station serving a critical area and elevated tank communication upgrades.
