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Physical Demands: this position requires work in both the office and in the field. It includes::

- Physical effort, including standing for extended periods of time, stooping, bending, and crouching during a regular work shift of at least nine (9) hours per day
- Ability to lift and carry, on a frequent basis, at least 50-90 pounds personally, and up to 150 pounds with assistance
- Maintaining constant alertness to the multiple concurrent activities of the construction site, including the activities of other employees and contractors, the operation of stationary equipment, and the movement of mobile equipment
- Frequently walking on uneven surfaces, including natural ground in varying weather conditions
- Capability to become certified to enter confined spaces, including climbing into and out of excavations up to 15 feet in depth, using ladders or crawling, as required
- Ability to maintain balance while working on watercraft or other surfaces
- Ability to climb on and off heavy mobile equipment safely

Work Environment: the work environment characteristics described below are representative of those that a Registered Land Surveyor encounters when required to be in the field to perform the essential functions of this position:

• Work is performed outdoors in all weather conditions

• The work environment periodically exposes employees to high levels of noise, grease, and dust that is typically associated with a construction project

- Employees work near heavy equipment and moving machinery
- Employees work in close proximity to high volumes of fast-moving traffic
- Work may involve a variety of substances commonly found on construction sites such as form oil, curing compounds, gasoline, diesel fuel, and ready-mixed concrete
